Welcome to our Autumn 2020 Journal! It's been a year of reflection, readjusting and learning like never before.

Even before we all had to spend longer indoors, there was an increasing awareness of the health and environmental benefits of wood floors compared to single use plastic-based floors such as LVT.

We know that well-made wood floors using high quality, environmentally friendly timber are some of the best flooring choices around. A lot of claims are made justifying the use of single-use manmade options, but the reality is that wood floors are much healthier for indoor environments than these plastic-based alternatives. Ted Todd floors more than match up in terms of being durable, hard wearing and easy to maintain, with the added benefit that the whole floor and not just off-cuts can always be re-used or recycled.

And it's not just what's visible that should be informing decisions around specifying flooring. Increasingly, companies need to prove their floors are VOC and SVOC free. While there is more awareness of VOCs generally, SVOCs, including phthalates, are notably more harmful. There are currently no legal requirements on these, potentially exposing those who use them to a variety of serious health complications.

We should all commit to lowering these VOC and SVOCs, and by using natural wood in projects, we can achieve just that. Yes, there are already a multitude of factors to consider when selecting the ideal flooring for your design but always be sure to consider the environmental impact behind your choice for a healthier, happier project and always say no to plastic.





LESSONS FROM THE PAST, INFORMING THE FUTURE

Customers are always fascinated by the nails we have to remove from reclaimed wood. They're an insight into the history of the wood and illustrate the time and care taken to make each one.

These lovely old clout nails were found in beams we've been recently working on - they're up to 16cm long and date back to at least 1820, when the property from which the boards were reclaimed was built.

At the time, making nails was a task given to apprentice blacksmiths to hone their craft, and it's also known that old nails were recycled and reused. Often, if nails couldn't be removed the timber would be burnt so they could be recovered.

Recycling and restoring what we have in order to breathe new life is something close to our heart too, and our Woodworks by Ted Todd team work tirelessly to give reclaimed and antique materials a new lease of life. They hand-brush, air-dry, carefully sand and more to ensure nothing is wasted from these valuable timbers, not even those challenging nails!

The result is flooring that not only radiates beauty, but also one that has new chapters etched into its history, and this is what reclaiming is truly all about. Taking every part of the old, and making it new with nothing wasted, only accentuated.
