We'll never charge extra for FSC<sup>™</sup> or PEFC certification. They come as standard with a Ted Todd floor, and always will.






## FINISHING TOUCHES

## HERRINGBONE LAYING PATTERNS

With herringbone patterned flooring, the blocks are cut in perfect rectangles then staggered slightly so the end of one block meets the side of another. This creates the iconic broken zigzag pattern you'll have seen on everything from wood floors to fabrics, paving slabs, architecture and even art.

Laying them in this end-to-side way is a traditional single herringbone pattern, but there are many other ways of installing herringbone blocks that will make a statement. Laying the blocks at a different angle, perhaps at 45 degrees or 90 degrees, will give your floor a different look. You can also install Ted Todd blocks in different patterns, such as basket weave, double basket weave or a boxed basket weave. There is also the running bond formation which can be laid at different angles, and even combined with basket weave or in a combination stack which will make your floor look one-of-a-kind.




