PROJECT OVERVIEW

The residential project features traditional interior design elements alongside historic original room features and quirks throughout. This style has been synonymous with the British country cottage for centuries and remains popular.

HOW WE HELPED

Collaboration began with our Woodworks team to make sure the flooring fit perfectly and complemented the historic, traditional architecture and design throughout the property. All whilst providing a striking and statement wood flooring solution for the library and orangery.


After discussing the project's requirements, samples were provided to the client, who even visited our workshops to see their flooring selections on a much larger scale.

Ruskin planks and Parquet de Versailles panels were specified for the two rooms. The Versailles panels and planks were combined inside the Orangery, leading through to planks running the length of the library, both of which granting a truly authentic feel and filling the space with historical impact and individuality.


OUTCOME

The wood used to craft the extraordinary Ruskin is 400-year-old French Oak. It's an extremely scarce resource which has been restored by our artisan craftsmen here in our English workshop to ensure that it will be enjoyed for many more centuries.

By using this antique oak throughout the downstairs of the home, the architect and client have created an encompassing and relaxing space that links both residents and guests back to the natural and historical world.

OUR CERTIFICATIONS EXPLAINED - RECLAIMED SUSTAINABILITY

Reclamation is a principle incredibly dear to us at Woodworks.

Not only is it where we began and blossomed our woodworking skills, it represents our sustainability mindset. Reclaimed wood flooring and wall cladding reduces environmental impact through re-use.

The wood is salvaged from the reclamation site, be it a historical building, warehouse or colonial home, before being transformed into a reclaimed floor at our English workshops.

This gives reclaimed wood a continuous lifecycle.

Many years ago, it was manufactured and installed into old buildings. It would be maintained here for decades before demolition took place, which is the key stage for us.

From here we recycle the wood, putting it back into the manufacturing stage, restarting its lifecycle again and again and increasing the longevity of the wood.

Then, throughout the years the reclaimed wood can age gracefully within your project and can even be re-worked, re-sanded and re-finished to inject new life. This does not only give woods a new lease of life, but prevents the need for more excessive numbers of trees being chopped down.

Whenever the cycle should cease, the wood is 100% biodegradable, helping your project reach carbon neutrality.
